

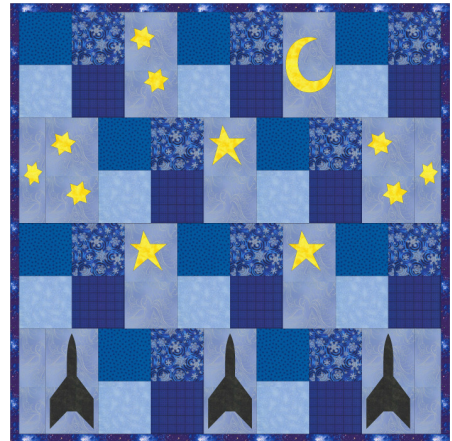
Blast off



A free pattern from Joanne's Designs
50" x 50"

Fabric

3/8 yard each in 4 different blues
7/8 yard in blue behind appliqué
3/8 yard in blue for borders
3/8 yard in yellow for stars & moon
1/4 yard in grey/black for rockets
1/2 yard for binding
3 yards for backing
Steam-a-Seam
*Measurement is based on 40" wide fabric
1/4" seam allowances included*



Cutting Instructions

Cut 10, 6 1/2" squares in each of 4 different blues = 40 squares
Cut 10, 6 1/2" x 12 1/2" rectangles in blue for appliqué
Cut 4, 3 1/2" x 12 1/2" rectangles in blue for appliqué & plain blocks
Cut 1 1/2" wide strips for borders.

Quilt Assembly

Following steam-a-seam instructions create 12 appliqué blocks. Stitch around each appliqué using your preferred method.
Sew 6 1/2" blue squares into 10 four blocks. Layout completed blocks as shown in quilt above.
Sew blocks together into rows. Sew rows together.
Measure quilt then cut borders to fit.
Sew borders on and complete quilt using your preferred method.
