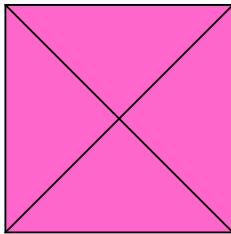


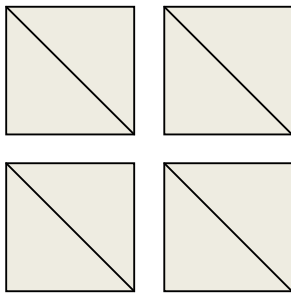
# Flying Geese Instructions

## Method 1

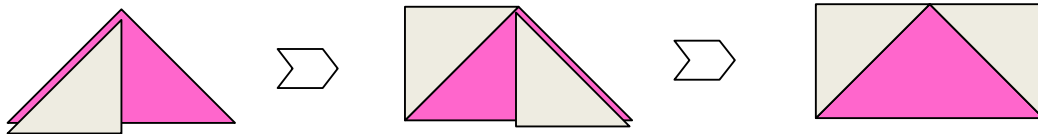
This method creates four flying geese units. It needs only 8 seams sewn.



Cut large square diagonally twice to make 4 geese triangles



Cut the 4 small squares diagonally once to make 8 side triangles.



Position and sew triangles as per diagram above.

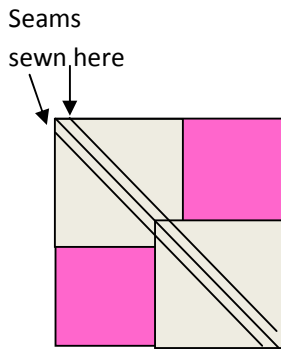
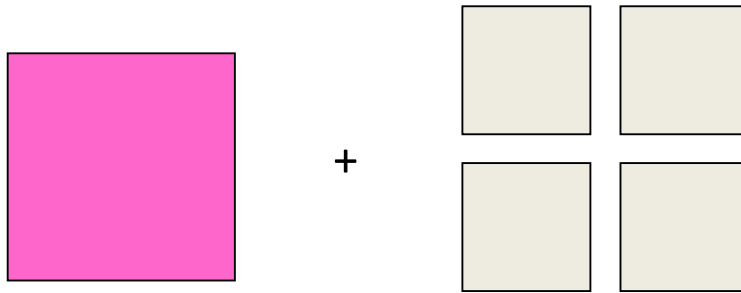
Repeat 3 more times.

All seams are a scant  $\frac{1}{4}$ ".

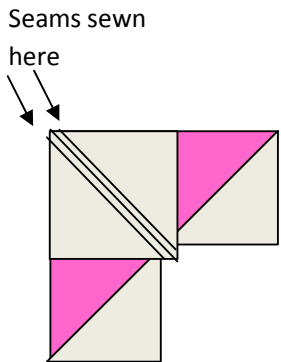
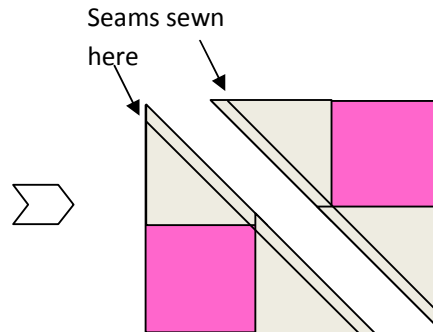
# Flying Geese Instructions

## Method 2

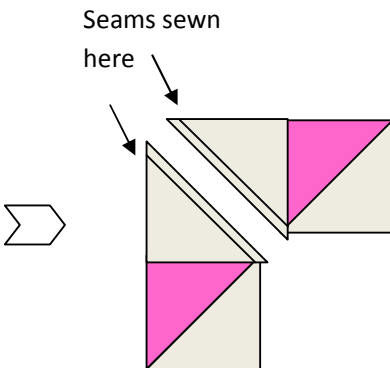
This method creates four flying geese units. It needs only 6 seams sewn.



Position squares as per diagram and mark the diagonal. Sew a scant  $\frac{1}{4}$ " seam either side of the diagonal line. Cut along diagonal line. Press Seams towards the small triangles.



Position a small square as shown. Mark the diagonal. Sew a scant  $\frac{1}{4}$ " seam either side of the diagonal line. Cut along the diagonal line. Repeat.



Press each flying geese unit.
