

# Greensleeves



A free pattern from Joanne's Designs

76" x 100" (approx)

This quilt is a great stash buster!

## Fabric

Large selection of greens, whites and blacks

3 yards for sashing

7/8 yard for binding

6 1/2 yards for backing

Batting

*Measurement is based on 40" wide fabric*

## Cutting Instructions

Finished blocks measure 21" x 21"

Cut your patterned fabrics into 2" wide strips then into 2" squares. Each block needs 152 squares. Total needed is **1,824** squares!

Cut **5** 3" wide x 73" long strips in white for sashing.

Cut **16** 3" wide x 21 1/2" long strips for sashing.

Cut **24** 2" wide x 15 1/2" long and **24** 2" wide x 181/2" long white strips. These are sewn around the inner 100 block piece.

## Quilt Assembly

Using 1/4" seams throughout.

Sew together 100, 2" squares into a 10 x 10 format.

Attach two 2"x15 1/2" white stripes to the sides then two 2"x181/2" white strips on the top & bottom.

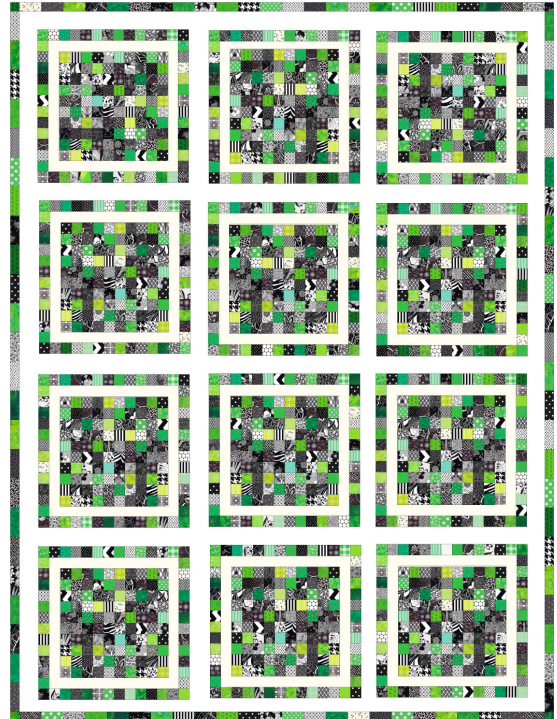
Attach strips of 2"x 2" squares. Two are 12 squares long and sewn to either side. Two are 14 squares long and sewn to the top and bottom.

Repeat making 12 blocks altogether.

Sew a 3" wide x 21" long sashing to the left-hand side of each block. Sew blocks together into rows then sew last sashing on the right-hand side.

Sew remaining sashing strips as in quilt above. Sew rows together.

Sew borders on and complete quilt using your preferred method.



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
