

Nine Patch Delight



A free pattern from Joanne's Designs
40" x 48"

Fabric

Selection of pink, purple, green, yellow & turquoise
Fat quarter for cornerstones
1/2 yard for sashing
1 1/4 yards for borders
1/2 yard for binding
3 yards for backing

*Measurement is based on 40" wide fabric
1/4" seam allowances included*



Cutting Instructions

Cut 108, 2 1/2" squares for nine patch blocks
Cut 20, 2 1/2" squares for cornerstones
Cut 31, 2 1/2 x 6 1/2" rectangles for sashing
Cut 7 1/2" wide strips for borders.

Quilt Assembly

Using 1/4" seams throughout sew together 2 1/2" squares to make the nine patch blocks.

Sew a sashing to the left-hand side of each block. Sew blocks together into rows then sew last sashing on the right-hand side.

Sew remaining sashing and cornerstones together into rows, as in quilt above. Sew rows together. Measure quilt then cut borders to fit.

Sew borders on and complete quilt using your preferred method.

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
