

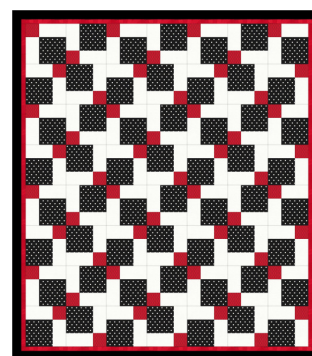
## Nine Patch Variation



A free pattern from Joanne's Designs  
69" x 78"

### Fabric

2 1/4 yards white fabric  
2 1/4 yards black with white spot fabric  
5/8 yard red fabric  
1/2 yard red border fabric  
1 1/2 yards black border & binding fabric  
*Measurement is based on 40" wide fabric  
1/4" seam allowances included*



### Cutting Instructions– per block

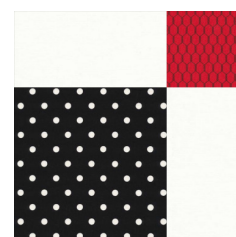
Cut 2 x white 6 1/2" x 3 1/2" rectangles. Cut 1 x red 3 1/2" x 3 1/2" square. Cut 1 x black 6 1/2" x 6 1/2" square.

Repeat to make a total of 58 blocks.

Cut 1 1/2" wide striped strips for red border.

Cut 2 1/2" wide striped strips for black border.

Cut 2 1/4" wide black strips for binding.



### Quilt Assembly

Sew blocks together then arrange them on a flat surface.

Sew blocks together in rows.

Sew rows together.

Sew red border on. Sides first then top & bottom. Repeat for black border.

Complete quilt using your preferred method.

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
