

Stars In Batik Quilt



A free pattern from Joanne's Designs

64" x 64"

Fabric

- 1 1/2 yards of white fabric
- 1/4 yard each of 2 green fabrics
- 1/4 yard each of 3 burgundy fabrics
- 1/4 yard each of 5 aqua fabrics
- 1/2 yard of green fabric for narrow border
- 1 1/4 yards of burgundy fabric for wide border
- 5 yards for Backing
- 1/4" seam allowances included

Cutting Instructions per block

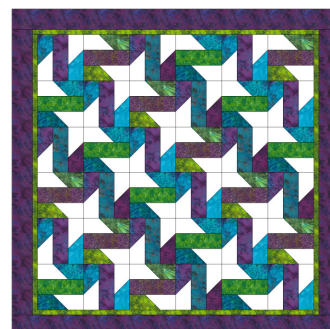
- Cut four 3 1/2" squares—2 white, 2 batik
- Cut one 9 1/2" x 3 1/2" rectangle—batik
- Cut two 3 7/8" squares—1 white, 1 batik, each cut diagonally once

Or

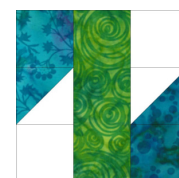
Make each block using the foundation piecing pattern provided.

Quilt Assembly

- Make 36 blocks as per above (I have used 4 color variations)
- Arrange blocks on a flat surface rotating half as needed. Sew together in rows and then sew rows together.
- Border with 1 1/2" wide green border. Sew on 4 1/2" wide burgundy border.
- Complete quilt using your preferred method.
