A free pattern from Joanne's Designs

58" x 72"

Fabric

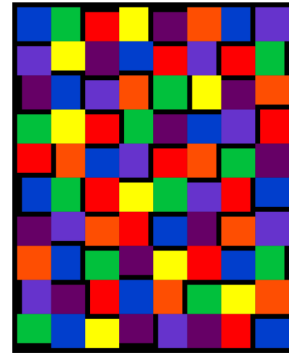
5/8yard each of 7 bright fabrics

1 1/2 yards of black for blocks, borders & binding

5 1/4 yards for backing

Measurement is based on 40" wide fabric

1/4" seam allowances included



Cutting Instructions

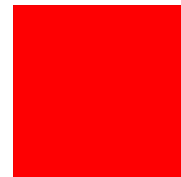
Cut 17, 7 1/2" x 7 1/2" squares from your bright fabrics.

Cut 63, 6 1/2" x 7 1/2" rectangles from your bright fabrics.

Cut 63, 1 1/2" x 7 1/2" wide black strips.

Cut 1 1/2" wide strips for borders.

Cut 2 1/4" wide black binding strips.



Quilt Assembly

Sew one black strip to each colored rectangle to create 63, 7 1/2" x 7 1/2" square blocks.

Lay out all 80 blocks in desired format.

Sew blocks together into rows.

Sew rows together to form quilt top.

Sew border on. Sides first then top & bottom.

Complete quilt using your preferred method.
